	0	Looking at the further actions we can take regarding judicial sovereignty (possible intertribal crime court, outlined powers to Grievance Committee, SCN-only tribal court) there is a distinct need for an Attorney General type position who can pick-up criminal investigations that the Grievance Committee may or may not depending on their future outlined powers Intertribal court is in talks right now, this is a benefit to us because it does not allow for an elected political administration to defund a stand-alone SCN court system over political issues, also allows for cheaper implementation (funded thru fed grants currently) of a court system that will still be culturally-sensitive in a way that CFR court is not Jack Brill no longer the prosecutor for this court, has not been for a few months, replaced by Kyle Alderson is a former DA
