Minimum Qualifications & Experience*

- 14 to 18 Years of age
- Tribal Enrollment Card
- Social Security Card
- Photo ID, Drivers License or Permit
- Ability to work with others
- Willing to work flexible hours including some evenings & weekends
- Work days can change due to weather.
- Knowledge of lawn equipment

While all aspects of this job cannot be described here, this job description does distinguish the Essential characteristics of this position. In most cases, applicants exceeding minimum Qualifications &/or experience will receive greater consideration for appointment.

All participants must wear closed toe shoes & the appropriate clothing.

(NO FLIP FLOPS OR SANDALS)

Workers will not wear clothing that unduly exposes the body, such as tops that do not cover the midriff, excessively low cut blouses or dresses, halter/tank tops, see-through clothing, or bike shorts.

Shorts, dresses, and skirts must be knee-length.

Those who are found to be in violation of the dress code shall be required to correct the problem or they will be sent home without pay.
